



Dear Freshfields friend,

We urgently appeal to you to help us give the precious gift of HOPE to animals who otherwise have no hope at all.

We are facing unprecedented demand for spaces in our rescue centres. Here's why:

- There is a massive overpopulation of pets across the whole country.
- Breeding is completely out of control, because of opportunist and illegal breeders, poor law enforcement and the lack of political interest in, and support for, grass-roots animal rescue.
- People are struggling financially to care for their animals more than ever.
- The combined efforts of all rescues cannot meet the overwhelming demand, us included.

Many more animals are dying. Too many of the animals that can't secure a rescue space are being abandoned on streets, picked up by wardens, and commonly put to sleep. Tragically, 99% of vets are being asked to put to sleep unwanted or unaffordable pets and are doing so for fear of a worse end for the animal.

It is heartbreaking to see more animals than ever suffering as a result of unreliable and irresponsible humans. It can seem like there is no hope for these lives at all - but we know that we are able to create hope.

- Create new opportunities to be rescued through a concentrated Foster Care recruitment drive. We can provide new Fosterers with the knowledge, training, equipment and supplies they need to provide warmth, food, love and safety from harm for those dogs, cats, rabbits, and horses that would otherwise be without hope.
