**Energy & Renewables:**

Over 50% of Ukraine’s energy infrastructure has been damaged or destroyed, with estimated recovery needs exceeding \$50 billion in the power sector alone. Ukraine is targeting a major shift toward decentralised and renewable systems, with ambitions to significantly expand clean energy capacity as part of long-term energy security and EU alignment.

**Manufacturing & Construction:**

More than 150,000 residential buildings have been damaged or destroyed, contributing to an overall reconstruction need of \$400+ billion. Since the Russian invasion of Ukraine, many factories have been damaged or forced to halt operations, particularly in eastern industrial regions.

**Infrastructure:**

Over 25,000 km of roads and critical transport links have been impacted, alongside significant damage to bridges, rail, and logistics hubs. Key systems such as transportation, energy, and water networks have been heavily damaged, disrupting economic activity and daily life.

**Agri-tech:**

Around 30% of agricultural land has been affected by conflict, with billions in lost output and urgent need for modernisation and yield recovery technologies.

# Social Value - Kyiv Regional Children's Hospital (Київська обласна дитяча лікарня)



Proceeds from this event will be used to fund urgent renovations at the Kyiv Regional Children's Hospital.

KRCH provides critical, life-saving services to around 1,200 children every month. It is the only facility in the region offering paediatric emergency care, end-of-life support, and specialist burns treatment. Despite this, it is operating under immense strain, struggling with limited bed capacity and significant infrastructure damage following occupation.

Ongoing attacks on energy infrastructure mean the hospital must rely heavily on diesel generators to function; consuming approximately 120 litres of diesel per hour just to keep essential equipment running, including incubators and life-saving medical devices.

- Paediatric Major Burns Unit (only one in the region)
- Specialist Paediatric Emergency Care Unit (only one in the region)
- Paediatric End-of-Life Support Unit (only one in the region)
- Heroes Unit – for children suffering war related injuries

- 33Kw Diesel Generator
- Grid-Access (limited/damaged)

# Opportunities Snapshot

## Kyiv Hotel (Kropyvnytskyi)

The Kyiv Hotel aims to modernise facilities in order to attract international travellers and businesses into the local area.

This will include the development and refurbishment of hotel rooms, restaurants, cafes, conference halls and sports facilities.

The building was built in 1975 and is 7,700sq meters, with 162 rooms.

The building has a physical depreciation rate of 38.3% from the time it was built. Its last valuation was done in 2017 and was valued circa \$2,611,752.

**Total: \$6,400,000**

## Displaced persons residential complex in Oleksandriia

Since the start of Russia's full scale invasion of Ukraine circa 11,000,000 people have been displaced.

A breakdown of the displaced populous can be shown as:

- 3.7m displaced internally across Ukraine
- 6.9m displaced across Europe and North America

A residential facility situated in Oleksandriia has been designated as permanent infrastructure for persons fleeing occupied and bombarded territories and requires investment to upgrade existing facilities including:

- Renovation of 25 rooms within the complex
- Installation of kitchens
- Installation and upgrading of heating and energy systems
- Installation and upgrading of bath and washroom facilities

**Total: \$20,000,000**

## Construction of microdistrict - Krpyynytskyi

Planning approval granted for 40 hectare site for the building of:

- 20x 5 story apartment complexes (2000 apartments)
- Construction of a school & kindergarten
- Construction of leisure centre
- Construction of football pitches
- Construction of medical facilities

Building parameters:

- 53,000sqm
- 750 single room apartments
- 675 double room apartments
- 75 three room apartments
